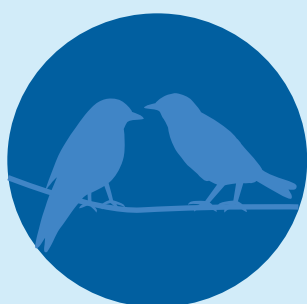




Fiction and Nonfiction Pairings

About This Brochure

Some students would rather explore books that are objective, scientific, historical, or factual; others will gravitate toward fantasy, thrilling narratives, or works that help them make sense of their own lived experiences.

Just as we adjust our lessons to meet the needs of students with different learning types, we might also update our bookshelves and our curriculums to satisfy the different ways students process information.
