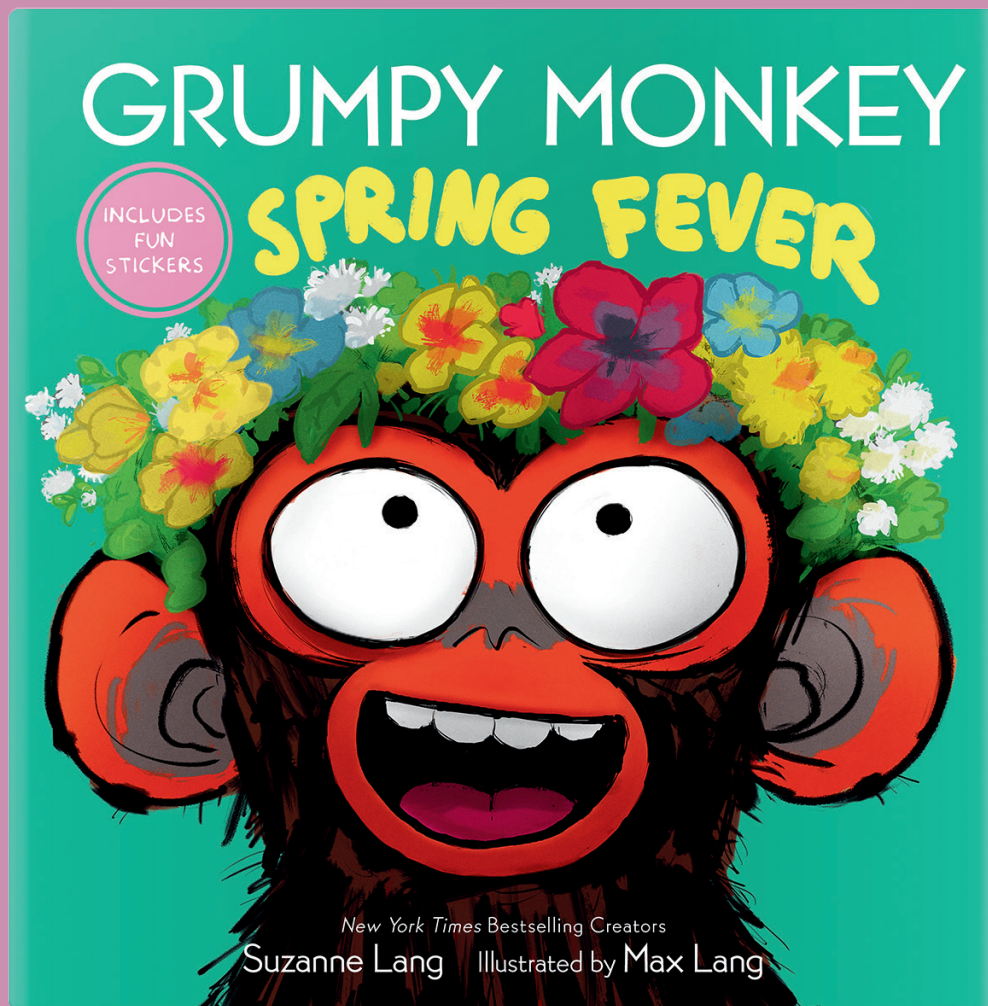

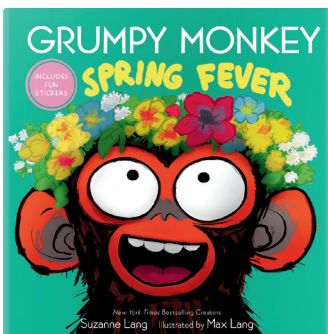

# Create Your Own Flower Crown!

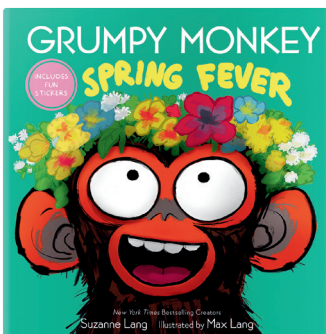
Jim Panzee celebrates spring by wearing a flower crown. Use the following instructions to create your own! If little readers are creating, make sure to ask an adult for help with the scissors!

## What You Need

- 2 Sheets of A4 paper (green if you want to save on coloring time!)  
1 sheet of white letter paper • Scissors • Tape or glue
- Optional: pipe cleaners, glitter, pom-poms,, etc. for decoration

## Directions

- For the base of the hat, cut a sheet of green A4 card in half to create two long strips.  
If you are not using green paper, color your paper before cutting.
- With the help of an adult, cut thin triangles from the other sheet to create strands of grass and flower stems.
  - To create decorative flowers, use spare paper to draw and color before asking an adult to help cut them out to attach them to the crown.
  - Add more decorative elements to your crown with tape or glue.
  - Use tape to attach the ends of the crown together to create a wearable headpiece!
