



U Is for Unicorn

What you'll need: colorful construction paper, colorful pipe cleaners, a googly eye, scissors, markers, glue

Draw a large bubble-style U on paper and cut it out. This will be the body of your unicorn. Next cut out an oval shape for the head, a smaller oval for the ear, and a long, skinny triangle for the horn.

On a second piece of paper, glue down the U-shaped body and the unicorn's head, ear, horn, and googly eye, and draw on a unicorn smile!

Cut out inch-long strips of pipe cleaner for the tail and mane of the unicorn, and glue them down.

Hang up your U is for Unicorn craft!

What you'll need: colorful construction paper, pencil, scissors, tape

Measure 3 inches from the base of the paper, and mark a light line with pencil.


- Cut 15–20 strips, leaving the 3-inch-wide strip intact.



He opens many books in his search, but quickly closes them when they don't turn to gold. That changes one day when he opens a book, looks at the page, and a question pops into his mind. Monster Masks



 $\label{eq:what you'll need: white cardstock, gold glitter paint, paintbrush, markers$


- Cut out a 6" x 2" bookmark from white cardstock.






Grab your blankets and pillows! From the creators of Finding Wild comes a new picture book that follows the changing of the seasons and is as cozy as a fort.

Popsicle Stick Fort

What you'll need: Popsicle sticks, wood glue, markers

Decorate your Popsicle sticks!

Line up eight Popsicle sticks, and add a line of glue to the top and bottom. Place a Popsicle stick on your glue to hold the bunch together. Make three of these.

Glue two of the bunches together by leaning them against one another to form a triangle shape, which will be the walls of your fort.

Glue the walls so that the third bunch creates your floor. It should look like a tent!
