
- Color the top of the paper plate red, leaving three lines of white dashes across the middle.



What you'll need: yellow, black, and red construction paper, colorful markers, a pencil, googly eyes, glue, scissors

- Trace your forearm and hand with a pencil on the yellow construction paper; cut out the shape.
- Cut out two circles out of black construction paper for ears, and then glue them on two fingers. Cut out a red bow-tie, and glue right under the hand. Write your name on the bow!
- Color brown spots all over the giraffe! Then draw on a mouth and nose, and glue on the googly eyes for your own giraffe friend!



What you'll need: a toilet paper roll, a variety of paint, a paintbrush, googly eyes, marker, scissors, glue

- Using different colors, paint designs on the tentacles, and add a mouth. Glue on the googly eyes.

What you'll need: 9 large Popsicle sticks; black, white, yellow construction paper; blue marker; scissors; glue

- Color all of the Popsicle sticks blue and glue 5 together, and then glue the other 4 together. When dry, glue the group of 4 perpendicular to the group of 5.
- Cut out two black circles and two smaller yellow circles for the wheels. Cut a mouth and two rectangles from the white paper and cut small black circles for the eyes; glue everything onto the truck.

A delightful book of curious, little-known "facts" about animals—one for each letter of the alphabet!

Did you know that chipmunks love to stay up past their bedtime? Or that dragons cry at happy endings? I bet you'd never have guessed that iguanas sometimes get homesick at sleepovers. Sara O'Leary pulls back the curtain on the animal world and gives us an absolutely charming little one-line "fact" about one animal for each letter of the alphabet. Kids will love to see their own quirks reflected in these adorably rendered creatures, and perhaps will be comforted to know that—just like them—narwhals can be perfectly happy all on their own, and quail also get tired of being told to be quiet.

In this sweet picture book that celebrates selflessness and the joy of helping others, a little bear named Harold loses his beloved woolly hat—only to discover that others need it more.

What makes a bear special? For Harold, it is his favorite striped woolly hat. He wears it when he sleeps, when he goes to school, and even when he takes his monthly bath. But when a crow whisks the hat off his head and high up into a nest, Harold doesn't feel so special anymore. He tries everything to get it back—offering the crow blueberries, worms, and even shiny objects—but alas, the crow will not budge. Turns out that the hat has a new special purpose: keeping three baby crows warm. This heartwarming picture book features an irresistible bear and gently reinforces the notion that it doesn't matter what you have; it's who you are that matters.

O Is for Owl!

What you'll need: brown, yellow, black, orange, and white paper; scissors; glue; markers

- 1 Trace a capital bubble-letter O on the brown paper; cut it out and glue to the white paper.
- Cut out two wings and a triangle for the head from the brown paper, a small triangle for the beak and two feet from the orange paper, and two yellow circles and two smaller black circles for the eyes.
- Glue everything you cut out onto the owl to create your O Is for Owl friend!
- Read about how owls are good at keeping secrets with your new owl friend!

Harold Loves His Woolly Hat Vern Kousky

Your Own Woolly Hat!

What you'll need: large white construction paper, red and yellow markers, cotton balls, glue, scissors, stapler, pencil

- Make your hat: draw a large semicircle on construction paper and cut it out. Bring the ends together and overlap the sides to form a cone; staple at the base.
- 2 Color the hat red and yellow, like Harold's!
- Glue a few cotton balls together; when they're dry, glue the group to the top of the hat.
- Read Harold Loves His Woolly Hat with your own hat!
